



How Can a Willow Ridge Parent Demonstrate Our School-Wide Expectations?

Respect Yourself and Others

- ❑ Use appropriate language and tone while at Willow Ridge School.
- ❑ Use the appropriate communication channels to address a problem.
- ❑ Plan to meet with or speak to teachers during non-instructional times.
- ❑ Understand and enforce the school dress code, which can be found in the student handbook on the GLPS website under Parent Resources.

Interact Safely

- ❑ Drop off and pick up students in designated areas.
- ❑ Sign your child in and out of school by stopping in the office.
- ❑ Allow a child with a temperature above 100° to rest at home. Students should be fever free for 24 hours before returning to school.
- ❑ Make sure your child is bringing appropriate items to school.

Give Your Best

- ❑ Become a member of the PTA or volunteer to help at the school.
- ❑ Know your child's teachers and friends.
- ❑ Make sure your child has good attendance and arrives on time.
- ❑ Make sure your child comes to school well rested.
- ❑ Remind your child of school-wide expectations.

Help Others

- ❑ Notify the school of any changes in behavior or home situation.
- ❑ Inform Office of any medication changes or illnesses.
- ❑ Give the school your emergency contact information and keep your phone numbers and address updated.
- ❑ Communicate any concerns regarding your student to classroom teachers, counselors, or administrators.
- ❑ Try to schedule your child's appointments and vacations during breaks.

Take Responsibility

- ❑ Call the school to report an absence.
- ❑ Keep up with your child's assignments and homework.
- ❑ Participate in your student's conferences.
- ❑ Communicate the importance of school and education to your student.
- ❑ Acknowledge good grades and behavior!
